

## **Closet Inventory Form**

**Hanging Items:**A garment's hanging length is the distance from the top of the hanger to the bottom of the garment. Example: 60" of long dress hang equals 5' of total hanging rod space or approximately 40 dresses.

MEASURING TIP: Add the total number of inches each type of clothing takes horizontally on a hanging rod. If you count the garments individually, allow for 1.5" of space per garment.
